

## Commonly Asked Questions About Staying at the Leadership Institute

Question: How much does it cost to stay in the dorms and are there any meals provided?

Answer: There is no charge to stay in the dorms. With regard to meals, many of the schools will provide lunch, and some even provide three meals a day.

Question: Can I stay in the dorms the day before and after the school?

Answer: Yes; the night before, the nights during and the night the school ends you are welcome to stay in the dorms. Please notify your school administrator at least a full business day before you plan to arrive at the Leadership Institute.

Question: Are the dorms co-ed?

Answer: No, the dorms are not co-ed. Married couples have to stay in separate dorms.

Question: Will there be a chaperone at all times?

Answer: No, however, a trained security guard is present outside of regular business hours.

Question: Is the Leadership Institute located in a safe area?

Answer: Yes, the Leadership Institute is located in the beautiful and safe Clarendon community of Arlington, VA.

Question: Will I have time to sight-see?

Answer: Most likely you will not have enough time to sight-see during the day. Most schools last for a full day. If you would like to see the sights, plan to come a few days early or stay a few days after the school ends. Ask your school recruiter for specific schedule information. Again, free housing at LI is available only for the night before, the nights during and the night the school ends.

Question: Is there a TV?

Answer: Yes, there is a large TV and a video library in the student lounge.

Question: Should I bring my own alarm clock?

Answer: Yes, bring your own alarm clock.

Question: How should I dress?

Answer: Dress professionally but comfortably.

Question: Are there phones in the building?

Answer: Yes, there is a phone provided in the lounge for local calls. This phone is available for outgoing calls only.

Question: Does LI provide internet access, a fax machine, or a printer to students (especially those in the dorms)?

Answer: No, LI cannot provide business center services to students either attending the classes, or staying in the dorms. There are several wi-fi coffee shops and a Fedex Kinkos not far from the Institute. Students staying in the dorms will receive a list of these locations when they check-in to the dorms.

For your stay in the Leadership Institute's dormitory the following items are provided free of charge.

Bath towel -- no hand towel or wash clothes

Sheets

Pillows

Blankets

Shampoo

Soap

Use of an iron

Earplugs
